Complaint:

Female resident of _____ called police on Sunday the 30th of July, 2006 by dialling 911 to report a dispute with her ex-common-law

Location:

Smith/Ennismore/Lakefield Township.

History:

The complainant, _____ and the suspect _____ been in a common law relationship for the past 5 years. They are currently separated. She resides at the above mentioned location and he resides at _____

They have one daughter in common and she resides with the mother. Police have been to the residence of the complainant in the past the most recent being a month and a half ago when he called and requested police presence under concern that an argument might escalate between him and the complainant, to which he wanted the police to remove him from the residence. Police attended and he ended up being placed in custody to prevent breach of the peace.

On Sunday the 30th of July, 2006, at approximately 0450 hrs police were called to the residence of the complainant when she dialled 911 seeking assistance after becoming involved in a verbal argument with her intoxicated ex-boyfriend. The argument was over the vehicle keys, in which he was sleeping in after returning from the party that the couple attended earlier.

Investigation:

On route to the call police received another 911 call from the complainant stating that he had left the vehicle and was walking down the street.

Upon attendance the investigating officer, PC Harry CHASE spoke to the complainant and ascertained that no criminal offence had taken place and confirmed that the reason that she had called the police was out of concern for her safety and his safety since he was intoxicated.

The investigating officer's searched the neighbourhood and was unable to locate the suspect.

In light of the information received and being that there was no Criminal Offence committed there will be no further investigation.
