**SUBJECT: REQUEST NUMBER CSCS-P-2011-00058**

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This letter is in response to your request under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act) for access to Ontario Provincial Police records.

Please be advised that access to the requested information is denied in accordance with section 65(6) of the Act.

Section 65(6) states that the Act does not apply to records collected, prepared, maintained or used by or on behalf of a ministry or agency in relation to any of the following:

- (1) Proceedings or anticipated proceedings before a court, tribunal or other entity relating to labour relations or to the employment of a person by the institution;
- (2) Negotiations or anticipated negotiations relating to labour relations or to the employment of a person by the institution between the institution and a person, bargaining agent or party to a proceeding or an anticipated proceeding;
- (3) Meetings, consultations, discussions or communications about labour relations or employment-related matters in which the institution has an interest.

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The Ministry is of the opinion that section 65(6) is applicable in the circumstances of your request. As a result, the records you have requested are not accessible under the Act.

This decision was made by the undersigned. You are entitled to appeal this decision within 30 days to:


