Dear Mrs. D'Souza:

I retrieved the Purolator package you sent me today. One of the four items contained was PC Bruce Hanna's notes.

Though there are only four pages of notes, they are not discernible. I am sure that when you viewed them you also had problems discerning his writing. Kindly have them transcribed.

I would also ask that in the future should you have further arguable material to be disclosed kindly make sure that one can read them.

Furthermore, I notice that in the application before the Tribunal there is a formal request for disclosure of Mr. Jack's entire red jacket file. Though it is not called a red jacket file in the application its contents are clearly stipulated in the applicable section. I am yet to receive a copy of such. Mr. Jack also sent numerous e-mails during his brief tenure with the OPP to the individual respondents. The e-mails in your entire disclosure fails to reveal the numerous e-mails Mr. Jack sent to the now various respondents (with the exception of two or three). All his e-mails are easily accessible via an e-mail audit if it has not already been done.

Though you have provided a copy of Mr. Jack's notebook entries, the copy provided is only the relevant entries pertaining to defense's position. I would ask that you kindly have the respondent also provide a copy of all his notebook entries regardless of whether they are for the applicant or respondent.

The April 10th deadline for complete disclosure is looming near. Mr. Jack and I would like to have the opportunity afforded to us to view the requested material made out in the formal request via the application.

I apologize in advance if there is a procedure that stipulates that requested material pursuant to the authority of the Code shall be produced at the commencement of a hearing. I can't see that being the case because an applicant would be denied the intended benefits of the requested material. However, I could be mistaken.
